OLD PAINT: OIL BASE:

Store in a safe place until the next HHW Collection

CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL:

- * Northern Disposal Transfer Station 378-4657 (fee involved)

TIRES: Store until next collection (fee involved)

PLASTIC BAGS: Re-use @ your local library or re-sale shop

PACKING PEANUTS: Sleeping Bear Apiaries 882-4456

STYROFOAM: Collections held throughout 2012

TRASH: Northern Disposal 378-4657

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Tires, Styrofoam & Electronics collections are set for June 9 @ Frankfort Industrial Park Recycling site location and August 11th @ Honor Road Commission location. There is a charge for tires. Call 882-0554 to schedule an appointment

Items accepted include expired medicines, chemicals & pesticides, oil base paints, cleaning solvents, fluorescent bulbs & CFLs, household batteries (terminals must be taped on all batteries over 1.5 volts). Unacceptable Items include latex paints, water based products, clean used motor oil, automotive batteries. Businesses are welcome to use this collection for a fee of \$1.00 per pound and will need to make an appointment also.

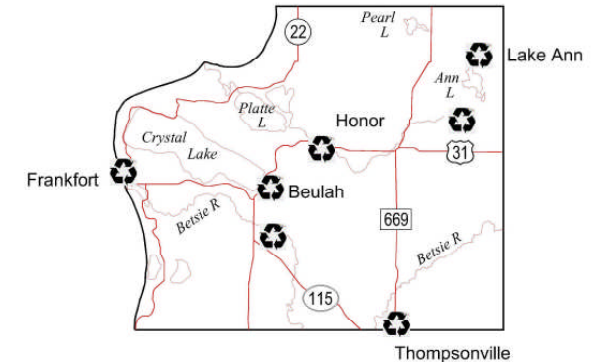
